





Senior Class History



As I sat through another one of Central's infamous future enhancing class meetings, I fell asleep and quickly awoke to find myself in a casting call. The director entered with a purple megaphone and began to say, "Can't please have your attention?" All actors wanting to participate in the class of 2002, there will be four acts: the opening act as freshmen, Act II as sophomores, Act III as juniors, and the finale as seniors. All trying out for the opening act please step to the front." A rush of 284 freshmen entered the room, and I was quick to notice all Bill Dixon was president, McCall Lively was vice-president, Lindsay Holder was secretary, and Lacey Henry portrayed treasurer. Seventy-five students were a part of ROTC, 52 participated in Cultural Studies, and 30 played in the band. Holly Grissom and Rachel Binkley won the art award, Corey Evatt won the category of general business, and Adam Cutcher, Holly Denton, Chase Goza, Adam Pope, Antoinette Smith, and Tia Wortham all were scholars in English. Bill Dixon won awards in Cultural Studies, Drafting 1, and Latin II. Awardees also included Janie Kraft and Tia Wortham in Spanish, Derek Meeks and Jennifer Thomas in Algebra I, with Charity Lewis and Katie Wilson in Algebra II. Brooke Beavers was selected as Best-All-Around, and Nancy Ashby, Lindsay Bornhoeft. Bill Dixon, D.J. Ellis, Erin Lemon, Charity Lewis, Lynsye Lowy, Cory Richardson, Valerie Sullivan, and Katic Wilson all were being awarded for their expertise in biologic Next come the clubbers with 3 in student council, 4 in the Spanish Club, 32 in FCCLA, and 1 in FCA. The director came to the front again and echoed, "All those trying out for athletics, please step to the front." Ninety-seven competitors ran to the front in full uniform, and I noticed 23 in football, 4 in volleyball, 14 in soccer, 7 in basketball, 3 in tennss, 7 track runners, 3 wrestlers, 9 softball players, 15 baseball players, and Bill Dixon stroked his way in golf. Adam Pope, Matt Lawrence, Brent Eller, and Nick Kuehn played soccer, 13 played football, Yodawna Crawford, Katie Summers, and Nicole Dunklin played volleyball, 9 boys played baseball, and nine girls played soccer. Jessica Allison, Allie Gossett, and Gina Dodd twirled the flow. Section somers same with the chorus, while 23 ROTC members marched to the national author.
